In turn, he or she then installs the Wardens and Court.

Each Master takes the lead in developing our Company and its position within the City Livery Movement, building our links with other Companies, for example the 100+ Group and the Financial Services Group – two groupings of modern companies.

WCoMC has a growing vibrant membership. The new Master also takes the lead in guiding the contributions of our members, through our committees and panels, to continue our strategic development in the work we do and the enjoyment our members gain from mutual fellowship.

A key part of the Installation Dinner is therefore the address that the Master gives, indicating how he or she sees the year unfolding. Traditionally, this speech follows the address given by the Guest of Honour, who this year is:

- **Sir Anthony Cleaver** – a graduate of Trinity College Oxford and former CEO and Chairman of IBM UK, which is the connection with our new Master; Sir Anthony has also chaired the UK Atomic Energy Authority, the UK Nuclear Decommissioning Authority and the Medical Research Council. Most recently he was Master of the Worshipful Company of Musicians.
